

DR. RONNIE W. FLOYD

Dr. Ronnie Floyd served as President and CEO of the Southern Baptist Convention Executive Committee from 2019 through 2021. In his tenure, Dr. Floyd forwarded the Cooperative Program which is the financial fuel to fund the Great Commission ministries of the SBC statewide, nationally, and globally. He also led Southern Baptists to adopt a unified, Great Commission vision called Vision 2025. As he provided direction in these areas and more, he provided biblical, balanced and forward-thinking leadership to the denomination through the Covid-19 global pandemic.

Dr. Floyd's ministry began as a young man in his home state of Texas. Floyd was pastor of five churches over a span of 43 years, the last 32 of which were as Senior Pastor of Cross Church, a multi-campus church in Northwest Arkansas (1986–2019), where he was elected Pastor Emeritus upon his calling to the Southern Baptist Convention Executive Committee. During his time as a pastor, he was actively involved in the Southern Baptist Convention, including serving as a trustee with the SBC Executive Committee, GuideStone Financial Resources, and others. He was also elected President of the SBC from 2014-2016.

In addition, Dr. Floyd has served as the President of the National Day of Prayer and chairman of the board for the Family Research Council in Washington, D.C. He has interviewed with various media outlets and news publications, including the Washington Times, the Sunday edition of the New York Times, and also broadcast weekly on the DayStar Television Network. Dr. Floyd has authored 24 books and will always be a pastor at heart. However, his proudest accomplishments stem from his personal life and family. He and his wife, Jeana, have been married since 1976. They have two sons, who are both married, and seven grandchildren.
